Background	ORIL was an important God in the Grasslands, and was much worshipped in the farming areas around Tehmor and amongst the workers in the City's produce markets, whose livelihoods depended upon good Harvests. She appealed less to the City dwellers, who took the supply of food for granted. Her Temple in Tehmor therefore emphasised		

	<p>the parts of Her Creed that taught followers to be kind to each other and to enjoy life and its rewards, in order to appeal to the G/C part of the population. The death of ORIL on 7 VI 2501 changed all this, and the failure of the Harvest that Autumn hit the City hard, as KRAK walked abroad. Many former ORIL-worshippers turned to OPSOR, the new G/C Clerical God of Hope, Who rewarded their Hopes and Prayers by bringing them through the following Winter and interceding with the Gods of Nature to ensure the success of subsequent Harvests. Although many former ORIL-worshippers in the City were lost to TIPRE, trusting in Luck and placing bets on future Harvests, most of the rural Faithful trusted in OPSOR. OPSOR has since gained new followers in the City, as His message of Hope appeals to many, especially in the Western Slums. The Warrior Priests of ORIL had a Chapterhouse in Her High Temple in Tehmor. When the High Temple of ORIL was converted to the High Temple of OPSOR, most of them continued as Warrior Priests of OPSOR (sometimes known as HopeMasters), although a small group chose instead to found the new TIPRE Order of the Warriors of Fortune.</p>
Notes	<p>[Temple of ORIL may Create food and drink.] / [Warrior Priests of OPSOR may Fulfil Hope for + or -5% on success rolls and Temple or Warrior Priests may call on OPSOR once whilst Temple is Active for a Benison, by Hoping for something. For both Powers there is a 75% chance their Hopes will be fulfilled, and a 25% chance they will be dashed.] / SC: Faction does not include the Warrior Priests of ORIL / OPSOR of the Desert, based at The Oasis of Pineapples and Coconuts.</p>
