Random Event	The Harlequin is in town, spreading discordant "music". (Note that the Harlequin is an archetype whose identity is taken by various rogues, and is not necessarily the Agent of The Champions of ATAVAR.)		
Background	PAREL is the God of the Musicians, Buskers and Singers of Tehmor, and of everyone who loves a good tune. The bustle and clamour of the streets of Tehmor may seem discordant, but listen closer and they pulse to a steady rhythm. People sing as they hawk their wares, busk for spare coins, or just sing for the joy of life (or wail against its misery). Many of them attend services in the High Temple of PAREL simply to enjoy the beautiful uplifting Music that is made and to listen to some of the best choirs outside the land of the Elves. There is friendly competition for worshippers between the G/L Gods of the New Triumdeate, with PAREL		

	appealing to those who are more concerned with beauty and order than with dogma, and who have an ear for a good tune. A few of the Clerics of PAREL in the City belong to the small but legendary Order of Singing Paladins, who (it is said) can strike fear into the heart of a foe with a single note. The Choir of Paladins attracts packed houses to its annual concert.
