Background	CAERULAS was a False God in Tehmor before He was announced as Clerical on 24 XIII 2500. He had a small Temple by the East Phare, which was rebuilt as the High Temple of CAERULAS in Tehmor following His officially becoming Clerical. The Lighthouse Keepers of the East Phare had traditionally been CAERULAS worshippers (secretly with Clerical powers), and on the founding of the High Temple it formally assumed responsibility for the Phare, as the Temple of RAYLIT does for the West Phare. The Temple preaches a less extreme version of Lawfulness than that of SARAN, with more tolerance of other				

	Alignments and beliefs. The Creed tends to the metaphorical, presenting CAERULAS as a Light to guide the Faithful in a Lawful way of life. The Temple is generally supportive of the Conservative Party and works with the Temple of SARAN (which is more tolerant of it than SARAN Temples elsewhere), but is keen to emphasise its distinctiveness and lack of association with the Valdrean Empire or the Kingdom of the Dwarves. The few Lightbringers (Paladins of CAERULAS) use their Light Powers to good effect in helping clear out some of the Darker areas of criminality in the City.
