Description	A Public Execution is to be carried out.
Specify	If the On Trial Plot has been played in a previous Game Turn and has resulted in the conviction and passing of a death sentence on a Character, that Character will now be executed (if they are still alive and in custody). Otherwise, specify (i) the Character who will be executed, (ii) the Activated Faction to which they belong (which may be held by you) and the crime or sentence which has resulted in the death penalty.
Notes	Criminal executions by sentence of the Tehmorian Courts are normally carried out by a public beheading by the City Executioner on a scaffold in Citadel Plaza. Hanging is (by Grasslander custom) the usual sentence for horse thieves. Other judicial or quasi-judicial bodies may impose their own death penalties and method and place of execution (e.g. the Thieves' Guild of Tehmor favours turning the Prisoner loose naked on the streets and holding a contest for their head, the Merchant's Guild of Tehmor may require they pay their pound of flesh, and the Temple of HAERIM prefers hanging, drawing and quartering on the High Altar). The Plot is triggered by the Prisoner being taken from custody for the sentence to be carried out. The Activated Faction to which the Character belongs may seek to free the Prisoner, if in character to do so. The Temple of KOROS holds the contract to carry out executions for the City and plays the City Executioner if Activated and the sentence is being carried out by the City. Otherwise you play the Executioner. This Plot may not be played as a mob lynching (which is a separate Plot in an Expansion).
