No. & Name of Plot:	60. The Outpost
Expansion	Forgotten Factions
Description	A Faction sets up an outpost in the terrritory of another Faction.
Specify	Specify (i) the Activated Faction which establishes the Outpost, (ii) a Location, Sacred Circle or Otherworld of another Activated Faction (which may not be controlled by the same Player or their Ally) in which the Outpost is established and (iii) the nature of the incursion which has resulted in the Outpost. Place a Pawn for the Activated Faction which establishes the Outpost at the Location, Sacred Circle or Otherworld in which the Outpost is established to indicate its approximate position.
Notes	This Plot involves an incursion by one Faction into another's territory. In Tehmor it will involve moving into another building close by to compete for local business/followers. Outside Tehmor it will involve establishing a rival presence in an area of influence, for example (in SC) by establishing a rival Sacred Circle to compete for control of the local area of the Forest, or (in DD) by establishing a rival Dream of an Otherworld to compete for a link to the Hall of Mirrors. Role-playing the Plot will involve the struggle for control of the area of influence in which the Outpost is established. Other Factions may not specify they also establish an Outpost in role-playing the Plot, but may support either of the two rival Factions or seek to defend their own Locations in the Area/Forest/Domain. The struggle may result in the loss of overall control of a Location/Circle/Mirror by one Faction (in which case its Pawn is removed at the end of the Role-Playing Phase, the loss of control by both Factions by mutual destruction or abandonment (in which case both Pawns are removed) or an equilibrium being established (in which case both Pawns remain and are counted in determining overall Control of the Area/Forest/Domain). The DM will rule on the result.
